

Patient Guidance LiquiBand[®]

Your wound has been closed using LiquiBand® topical skin adhesive. The list below is to serve as a guide for you to understand and care for your wound following your procedure.

- LiquiBand® topical skin adhesive has been applied to close your wound
- You should not rub, scratch, or pick at the wound. Doing so may compromise the integrity of the wound closure.
- You should keep your wound clean and dry. Light showering is permitted.
- Although not necessary, you may apply a dry dressing to cover your wound. Do not place tape directly over the wound.
- Do not apply barrier creams, petroleum jelly, or mineral oils to your wound as this may compromise the integrity of the wound closure.
- ▶ If the appearance of your wound changes or becomes painful or if you have any concerns, please contact your medical professional.
- ▶ Keep wound protected from injury during the healing period.
- ▶ LiquiBand® topical skin adhesive will naturally slough off completely between 5 and 10 days after the procedure. By this time, your wound should be sufficiently healed.
